

Color Code Explainer
Explicit information the candidate opposes vouchers
Explicit information the candidate supports vouchers and is using it in the race
Nuanced position on vouchers
No color indicates a lack of information that vouchers are affecting the race
Note: The color codes do not indicate an endorsement, but are merely informational. The source of the information is in the comments. The color codes indicate bellwether races affecting the future of public education in Texas. Some incumbents voted for vouchers, but are not color coded. In those races, a candidate opposed to vouchers has not been indentified. Therefore, issues other than public education are affecting those particular races. A voucher is defined as any diversion of public money from the public schools to private education. As a 501c4, we cannot and do not coordinate with campaigns. This information is being compiled with the help of Texas Impact's Public School Defenders, which are members of the 501c4.
