With the Reverend Dr. Rebecca Todd Peters

Dr. Peters is professor of religious studies at Elon University. Her books include *In Search of the Good Life*, *Solidarity Ethics* and *Trust Women: a Progressive Christian Argument for Reproductive Justice*. Ordained in the Presbyterian Church (USA), she has been active denominationally and ecumenically for more than 25 years and currently represents the PC (USA) as a member of the Faith and Order Standing Commission of the World Council of Churches.

Definition: "Reproductive Justice (RJ) means the human right to control our sexuality, our gender, our work, and our reproduction. That right can only be achieved when all women and girls have the complete economic, social, and political power and resources to make healthy decisions about our bodies, our families, and our communities in all areas of our lives"
