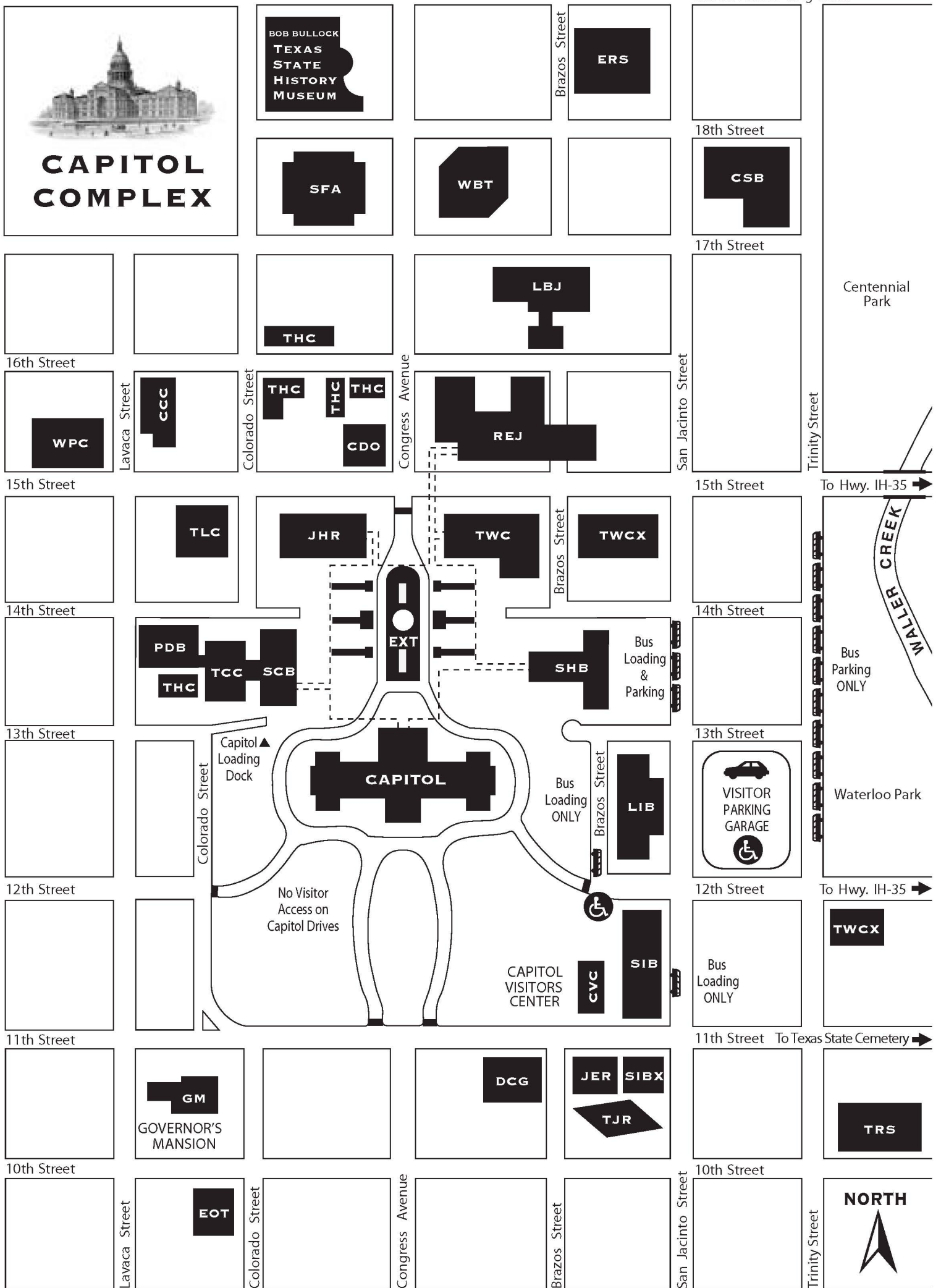

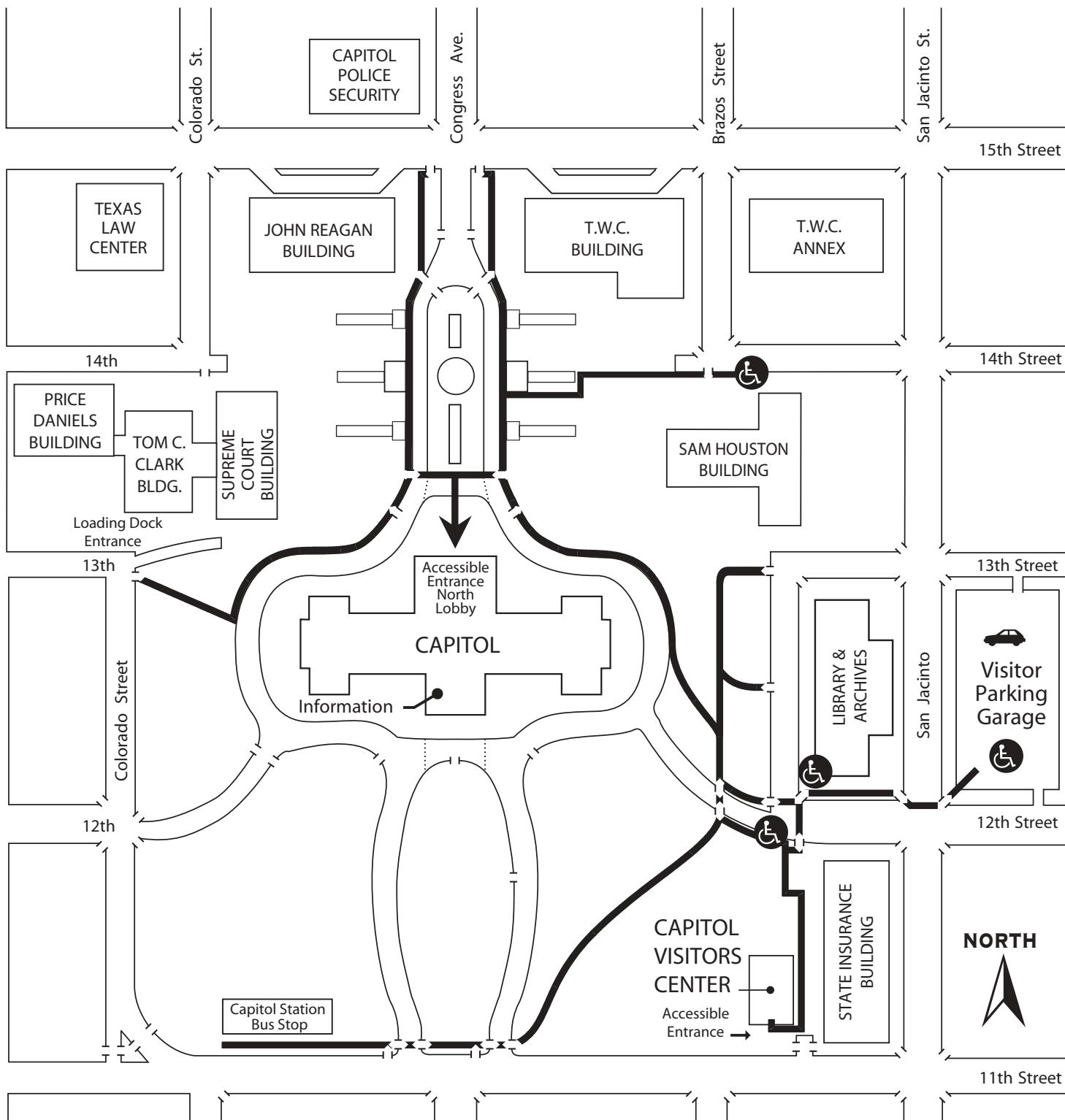

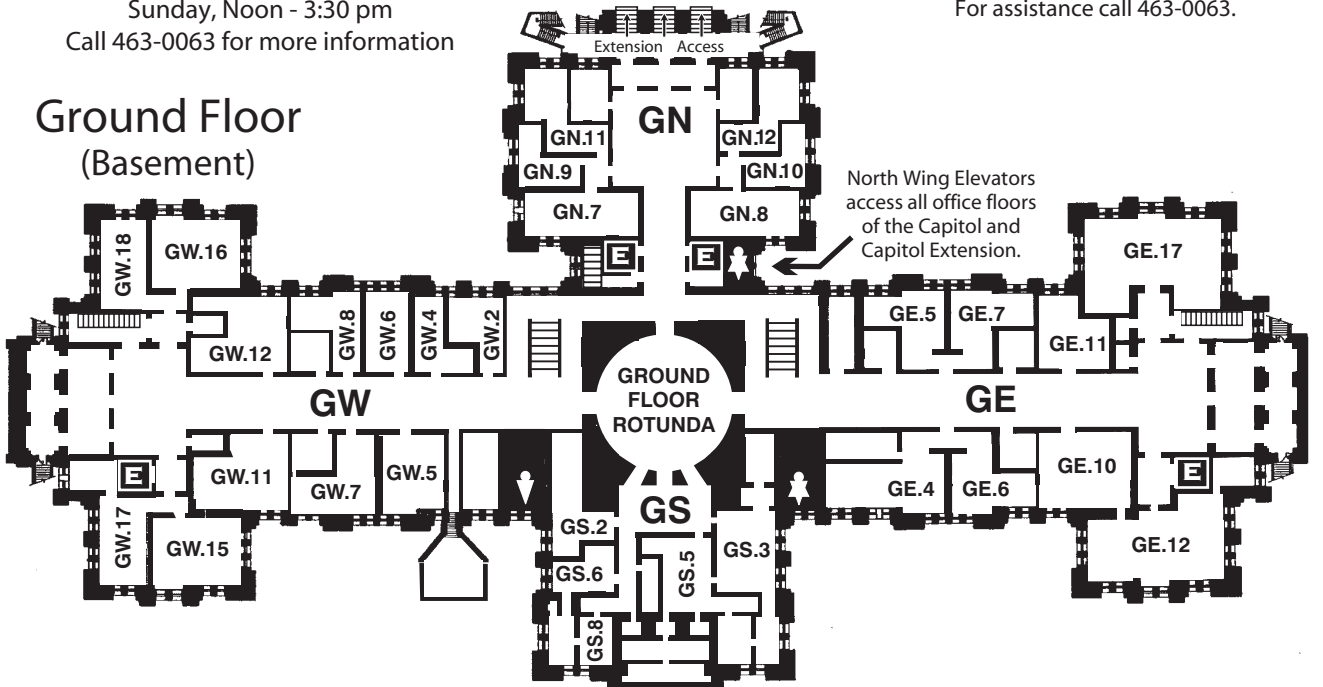
- PRIMARY ACCESSIBLE ROUTES
- CURB RAMPS

All Capitol, Capitol Extension and Capitol Visitors Center facilities are accessible to persons with disabilities. For special assistance, contact the Capitol Information and Guide Service at 463-0063, or visit their office in the Capitol, First Floor, South Wing. Watch for oval-shaped signs on the Capitol Grounds which indicate accessible routes. Vehicles properly displaying an official disabled parking placard or disabled parking license plate may park at any State of Texas controlled parking meter in the Capitol Complex for free at any time. Accessible parking is also available in the Capitol Visitors Parking Garage.

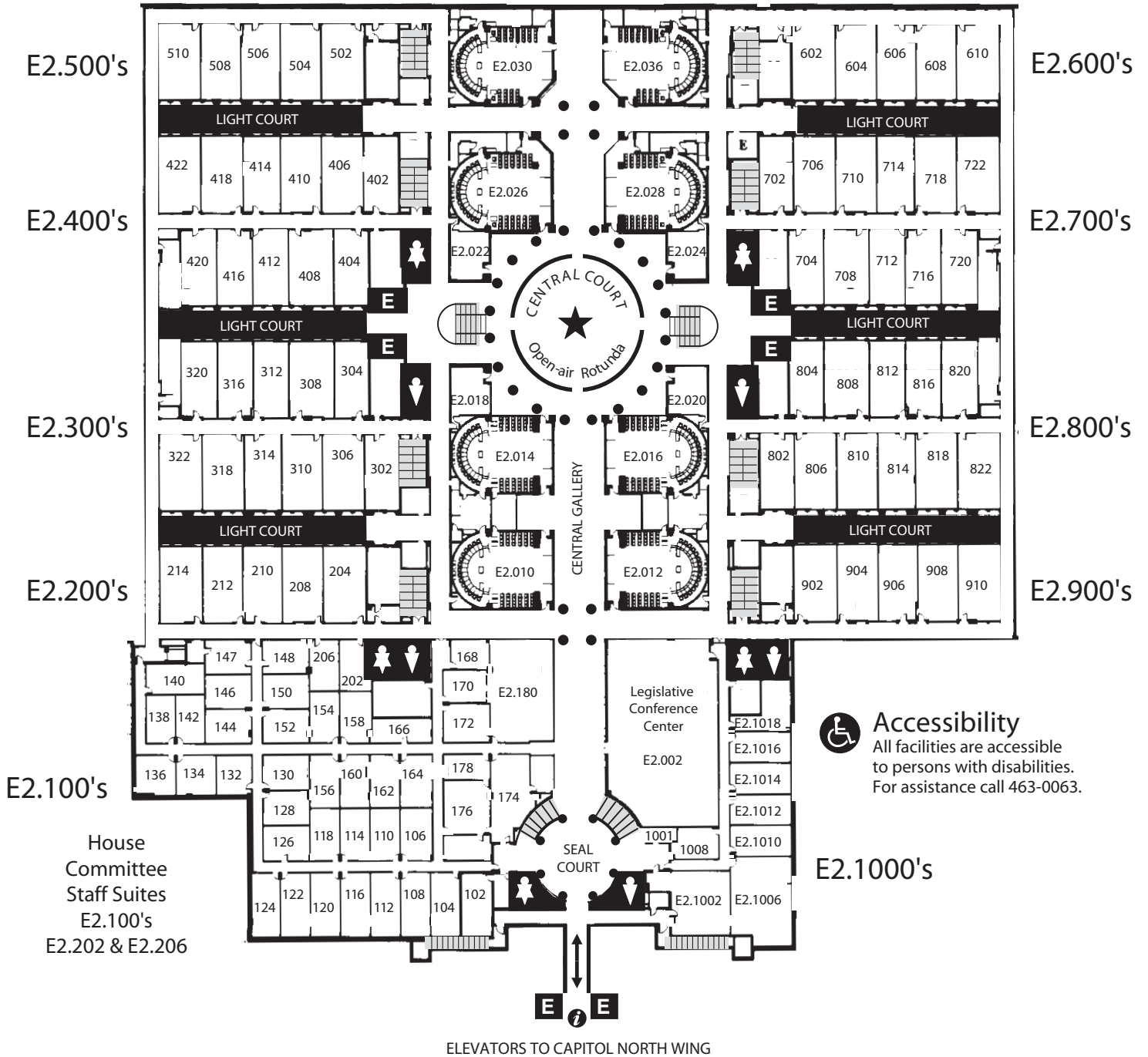
Extension First Floor (E1)
